Participant Evaluation Results

The 2016 JTO Connect event brought 64 to the Bergamo Center in Dayton Ohio on the weekend of July 29-31. Most were previous JTO-ers but a few spouses and newcomers attended as well. Not everyone stayed the entire weekend, but the program was flexible to accommodate our special guests. Feedback from the Evaluation was very positive with participants rating 4.82 on the question, "*This weekend was a good use of my time.*" See the rest of the results in the table below:

The lowest scores were around willingness to serve on a committee for a future JTO gathering and interest in participating in a virtual JTO Connect community. This is not, however, a lack of interest in future JTO Connect gatherings. 38 participants indicated they would like to participate in future JTO Connect events, with 22 indicating they would like it to continue as an annual event versus 11 who indicated an interest in an event every other year.

Overwhelmingly, participants indicated that beginning of July (n=19) or end of July (n=17) were desired timeslots for future JTO Connect gatherings.

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Analysis of Open Ended Comments

The program was very well received as there were 39 positive comments made on the Evaluation survey and 14 Thank You's to the Planning Committee.
