## **Participant Evaluation Results**

The JTO Connect 2017 brought about 45 people to the Spiritual Center-Maria Stein in Maria Stein Ohio on the weekend of July 28-30.

We had people from all over the Midwest (and one kinda southern guy) attend the weekend activities:

**EXPECTATIONS** (from the first session). Expectations seemed to center around 6 themes.

### **SURVEY RESULTS**

Feedback from the Evaluation (38 of 45 participants) was very positive with participants rating 4.76 on the question, "*This weekend was a good use of my time.*" See the rest of the results in the table below:

The lowest scores were around willingness to serve on a committee for a future JTO gathering and interest in participating in a virtual JTO Connect community. This is not, however, a lack of interest in future JTO Connect gatherings. 32 participants indicated they would like to participate in future JTO Connect events (84%, 4 blanks and 2 Undecideds), with **28 indicating they would like it to continue as an annual event!** At our final session discussion, participants clearly indicated that July is the optimal timeframe – not immediately before or after July 4<sup>th</sup>.
