He was a missionary in Africa for thirteen years, especially Zambia, where at St Bonaventure College, Lusaka, Zambia, he directed a House of Prayer for twelve years, giving directed retreats. He also lectured at that college on Franciscan Spirituality, Franciscan History, and the Writings of Francis and Clare. His interest in Franciscan study slowly developed: as if at first aware of superficial definitions, the Franciscan habit, Way of Life in Community, etc. Eventually, especially with extended visits in Assisi, Don read ...not able to put the book down – lives of Francis, his thought, his time, his spirituality.
